During 2017-2018 the Trustees continued the well established practice which ensure that the funds available for distribution reached “ the poor and needy” via Organisations which by their nature provide a service to those in the Village

A grant of £1,750 was made to the Hook Norton C of E school to ensure that Children from less well-off backgrounds were enabled to access the full curriculum.

The second grant of £500 was made to the Village Library through the FOHNCL for the benefit of users both within the village of Hook Norton as well as neighbouring rural homes and smaller villages.
