- 25 3 cooking apples P
- 26 3 dessert apples P

- 29 Minimum of 3 fruit one variety not listed above ** P
- 30 Heaviest potato
- 31 Heaviest vegetable marrow
- 32 Longest runner bean
- 33 Ugliest Vegetable you have grown
- 34 3 dahlias pom-pom
- 35 3 dahlias any variety
- 36 Collection of 3 edible cut herbs. Bowl max 9" diameter
- 37 Vase of cut flowers, 1 variety, max. 2' across
- 38 Vase of mixed cut flowers, max 2' across
- 39 A fuchsia grown in a container
- 40 3 stems of Michaelmas daisies, 1 or more varieties
A container of plants in flower or a hanging basket.

12" diameter max-novice only
- 52 Floating Flowers 12" max
- 53 An arrangement in an unusual container max 18" wide
- 54 An arrangement of foliage Max 18" wide - no flowers
- 55 An exhibit of berries from the hedgerow Max 18" wide
